APPLICATION FOR NEW ADDRESS

New street names and addresses are issued by the town upon application, in accordance with the Town of Jamaica Ordinance Regarding Street Names and Addressing, a copy of which is available at the town office. Electric power and telephone service providers are prevented by law from installing new services at any location for which an official address is not available.

Applicant must physically mark BOTH sides of proposed driveway with fluorescent flagging BEFORE submitting application. *(This is VERY important so 911 appointed agent can find and accurately measure the new 911 address.)*
