Agenda:

1. Review contract information to decide on a company for Jamaica transfer station waste removal.
2. Health issue re: private septic system.

Judy Flower moved to go into executive session to discuss proposal for the Transfer Station contracts. Motion was seconded. Vote was 3 for, Joel Bluming abstained, Lexa Clark was absent.

Judy Flower provided a spreadsheet with numbers to compare contracts between two companies. Judy Flower recommends TAM. Difference in cost will be discussed.

TAM – 2 prices for trash and C&D
TAM recommends fixed price, average ton 2.6 Tons
TAM suggests dual stream recycling.

Triple T does not do double stream or double haul.
Triple T - only does single haul, also tipping fees.

Judy Flower moved to hire TAM at a fixed price of #34,197.11 plus \$2,000.00 for organic waste collection. Joel Bluming 2nd, motion carried 3 to 1.
