- 1. Meeting call to order: Bryan called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.
- 2. JPC membership update and elections: John Sohikian was present, confirmed that his request letter to join the JPC was presented to the Selectboard, and is awaiting to hear confirmation status. Chris Robbins motioned to nominate Bryan Zieroff as new Chairperson of the JPC, which was seconded by Patrick McQuillan, and approved unanimously. - 9. Discuss/Plan for completing the amendment/adoption process of the Town Plan: The revised draft plan including the energy element and flood related revisions is complete, and the JPC will work to initiate the adoption process.
