Greg called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

- 1. Call for any late additions to the agenda Sign Permit Application
- 2. Approve the minutes from the April 11th Selectboard meeting

 Tom made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 11th meeting, seconded by Jessica. All in favor.
- 3. Review Road Reclassification Plan and Recommendations and determine next steps
 The Jamaica Planning Commission has been working on the road
 reclassifications with suggestions from residents and the road crew. They have
 come up with a proposal. The next step would be to notify all abutters that
 would be affected. Then there would be a hearing, followed by a decision to act
 on these changes.
 Tom would like to check out the roads before the hearing but would like to
 schedule the hearing. We do not schedule the hearing tonight.
 Tom would like to table this until the next meeting and go out and look at the

roads. The topic was tabled until the next meeting.

- 4. Review Culvert #48 (Pikes Falls Rd) replacement plan and bid timeline changes
 The initial plan was to put this out to bid, there was a mix up and the Reformer
 did not run the ad on time. Terri changed the dates and when she submitted a
 new ad, the old one had been published. There was a pre-bid meeting this
 morning. The bid deadline is next Monday at 6:30 p.m. which will be followed by
 a bid opening.
- 5. Delinquent Tax Sale date set for May 23
 We did not do a tax sale last year, the date is Monday, May 23rd. Typically the town sends someone to bid on properties. The town sells the property to the high bidder, but the owner has one year to redeem the property. Greg made a motion to appoint Jessica as the town's representative at the tax sale, seconded by Tom. 3

Greg would like to appoint someone not on the board as the sign administrator in case the sign permit is denied, then they could appeal to the Selectboard.
