REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL-BID

The Town of Jamaica is requesting sealed bids for the following project:

Old Route 8 Road River Embankment Restoration Project - RFP

Project(s) Description:

Work includes repairing the existing slope that separates Old Route 8 Road from VT Route 100 in Jamaica and stabilizing the slope with necessary protective measures. The work also includes repairing the existing guardrail and slope of the roadway extending down into Wardsboro Brook, through armoring and stabilizing this slope area.

The work shall include restoring the embankment slope that was damaged by the recent storm event run-off during the July storm event. The erosion on the lower embankment section of Old Route 8 Road into Wardsboro Brook extends approximately 25' down into the stream channel. The length of the embankment restoration project is approximately 170 linear feet, terminating close to the end of the residential fence with river stone support posts.

The design of the restoration project will incorporate a Placed Rip Rap Wall - Stacked Toe Slope design cross-section for the embankment stabilization effort. It is recommended that Type IV diameter rock be keyed into the in-stream slope section for the lower three courses of rock, to serve as the foundation for the sloping wall, and Type II diameter rock extending the remained of the embankment and transitioning to a stable fill material for the remaining portion of the slope to the roadway shoulder. The design is per the Vermont Rivers and Roads Field Manual.

The town will secure the necessary permits and permissions for any work done within state right-of-way and/or any stream alteration activities warranted through associated state agencies. The awarded contractor will work closely with the town in documenting repair activity entertained per Federal Guidelines for funding reimbursement, which may include specifics on detailed invoicing, pre/post work photos, material removal practices entertained, cost breakdowns, manpower and equipment utilized, etc.

Project Completion Date:

The project(s) completion date is the end of **November 2023**, with the State River Engineer determining the final completion date for work to take place within the stream this season.

Instruction to Bidders:

All bids must be submitted on the company letterhead to serve as the bid form document. The bid form must be filled out completely, signed, printed name of signature, and dated.

Handwritten bid forms must be done in ink and must be legible. Corrections to handwritten bid forms must be initialed and dated. Illegible bid forms will not be accepted. If multiple bids are submitted, only the last one submitted shall be considered. Previously submitted bids shall be discarded. Bids submitted as a lump sum for the project(s) will be rejected.

Bids must be received at the Town Office located at 28 Town Road, Jamaica, VT 05343 by **4:00 PM on November 6, 2023**. Sealed bids delivered by person, overnight express, courier, or parcel post must be clearly marked “**Old Route 8 Road River Embankment Restoration Project.**”

Award of Projects:

Selection will be awarded based on criteria of: 1) least total project cost and/or least cost per ton in place, 2) best qualified to perform the work in a time frame advantageous to the Town and traveling public, 3) ability in meeting the terms of the contract and ability to provide a quality product, and 4) past performance of the bidder under previous contracts with the Town and elsewhere.

Disclaimer:

The Town reserves the right: (1) to accept or reject any and all bids in whole or in part and to accept other than the apparent lowest bid price as read; (2) to amend, modify, or withdraw this Request for Bids; (3) to cancel any and/or all projects prior to the start of construction without prior notification; (4) to request submittal of supplemental documents or information from any and all bidders; (5) to accept or reject a bidder's request to hold a special pre-bid conference at a time and/or date to be determined.

The contractor agrees to furnish the necessary labor, equipment and material to perform all work in accordance with the Request for Bid, Additional Specifications, Project Documents, the State of Vermont Agency of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction 2018, and its latest revisions, and the latest version of the MUTCD.

Warranty:

The Contractor shall warranty materials and workmanship for a period of one year from the date of completion. Defects and associated repair shall be reviewed with the town prior to the remedial work. All remedial work shall be completed by the Contractor at no additional cost to the Town.

Insurance:

Bids should include a copy of Liability/Workman's Comp Insurance.
