

WARNING

The legal voters of the Town of Jamaica, in the County of Windham and State of Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at 10:00 a.m. at the Town Hall in said town of Jamaica, on the first Tuesday of March, March 3rd, 2026, to transact the following business and act upon the following articles:

Article 1: To elect a Moderator for a term of one year.

Article 2: To review the town report.

Article 3: To elect the following officers as required by law.

- a. Selectperson for a term of three years
- b. Selectperson for a term of one year
- c. Selectperson for a term of one year
- d. Lister for a term of three years
- e. 1st Constable for a term of one year
- f. 2nd Constable for a term of one year
- g. Trustee of Public Funds for a term of one year
- h. Agent to Deed Land for a term of one year
- i. **Library Trustee for three years of a five-year term**
- j. **Library Trustee for a term of five years**
- k. **Library Trustee for a term of two years**

Article 4: To see what sum of money the Voters will vote to pay the Town's running expenses, and how it will be collected.

Article 5: To see if the Voters will authorize the Selectboard to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

Article 6: Shall the Voters authorize the Selectboard to spend "unanticipated funds such as grants, gifts and/or interest"?

Article 7: To set the time for the opening of the next Annual Town Meeting, to be held on the first Tuesday in March 2027.

Article 8: To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

Article 9: To Adjourn.


