FY2027 Budget Revote

The legal voters of the West River Modified Union Education District (the “District”), comprising the voters of the towns of Brookline, Jamaica, Newfane, Townshend and Windham are hereby warned and notified that a revote of the FY27 Budget (Article 1) will be voted by Australian Ballot on **Wednesday, May 13, 2026**, at their respective polling places beginning at 9:00 a.m. in Brookline, 9:00 a.m. in Jamaica, 9:00 a.m. in Newfane, 9:00 a.m. in Townshend, and 10:00 a.m. in Windham. Polls will close in all such towns at 7:00 p.m. on the following articles of business:

Article 1: Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend \$15,062,658 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The West River Educational District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$16,162, which is (.83%) higher than per pupil education spending for the current year.

The legal voters of West River Modified Union Education District are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said annual meeting shall be provided in Chapters, 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

Upon closing of the polls, the ballots will be delivered to Townshend Town Hall to be commingled and counted by local town election officials who shall transmit the voting results to the Clerk of the West River Modified Union Education District, who will then tabulate and report the final results for the District.
